

- Leather (1.4ft<sup>2</sup> or 0.15m<sup>2</sup>)


# Legend

Optional punch/stitch hole


These holes are not necessary to make the pattern. Usually, they're added to minimise stretching and warping of softer leather over time.

Stitch-hole size: 1.5mm









# **Printing Guide**
